Method of analysis

837,242 Wales job ads have been analysed and matched to 7,199 of the skills in Pearson’s proprietary ontology. Using this monthly skills data from January 2020 to July 2023, skills fitting the following criteria have been identified:

- **Popular skills:** Skills which currently appear in the highest percentage of job ads; popularity is defined as the percentage of job ads the skill appears in.
- **Trending skills:** Skills which have experienced the greatest increase in popularity across the last year.
- **Emerging skills:** Skills which are expected to trend soon – skills which have historically been unpopular but show the early signs of future popularity.

Where a skill is flagged as specialised, either to a job or job family, this is because TF-IDF analysis has identified the skill as particularly important to this job/job family compared to all jobs, across all job families.

To find popular, trending and emerging skills by region, ads have been geocoded and mapped to a region. Each piece of analysis is by region – for example, popular skills in the South East Wales are those which currently appear in the highest percentage of South East Wales job ads.

Regional boundaries

Within Wales, 22 council areas (2022) correspond to 4 NUTS 3 regions. The council areas are aggregated to regions as follows:

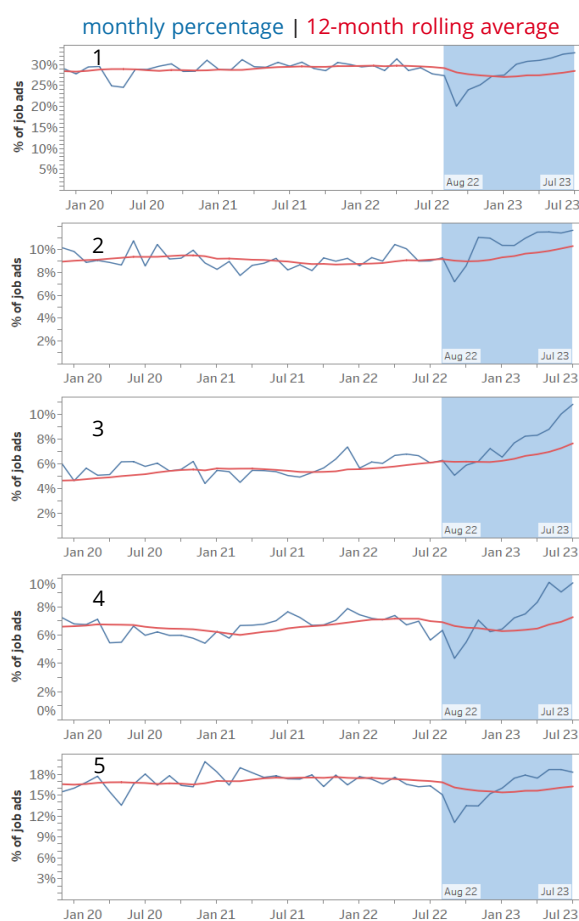

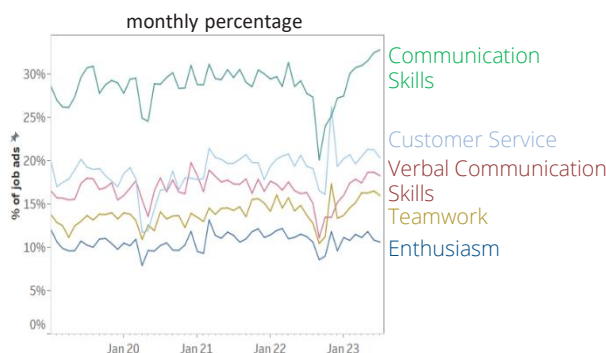

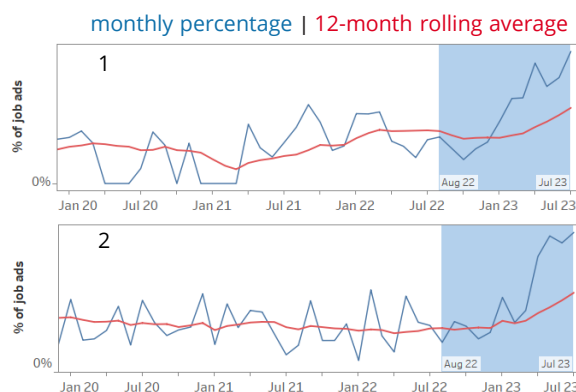

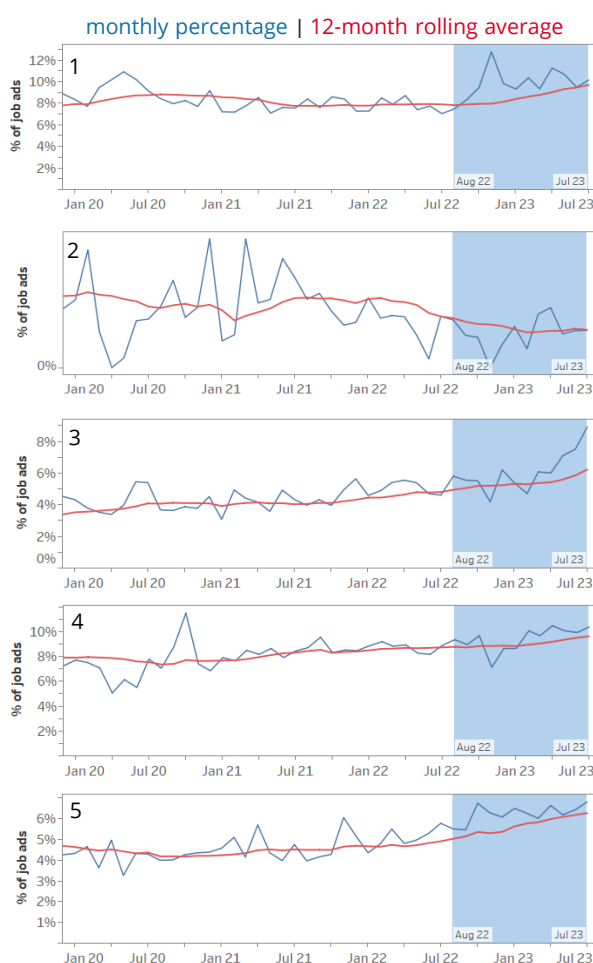

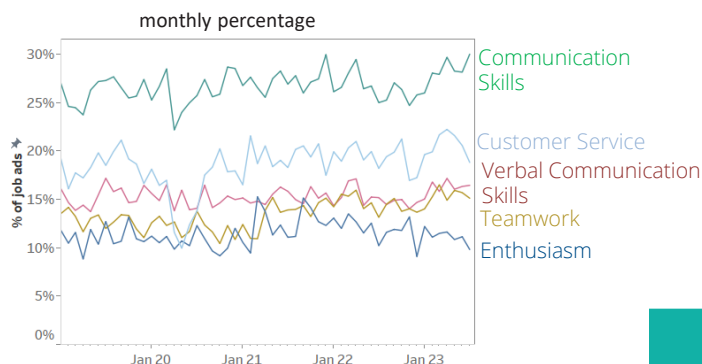

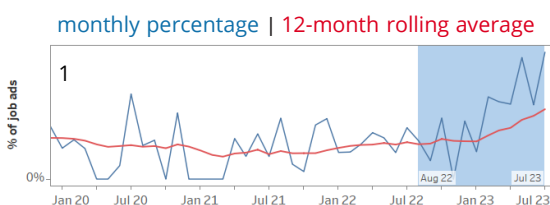

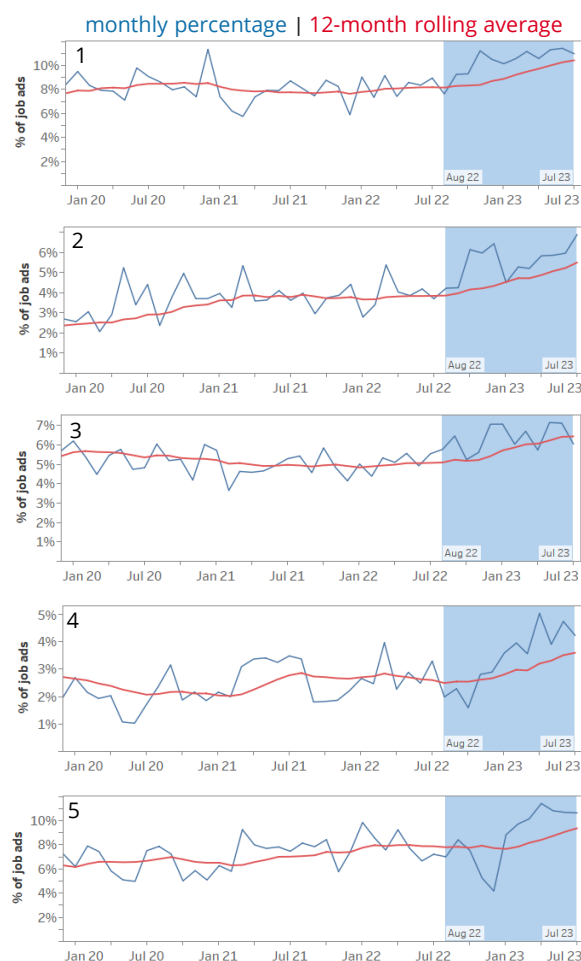

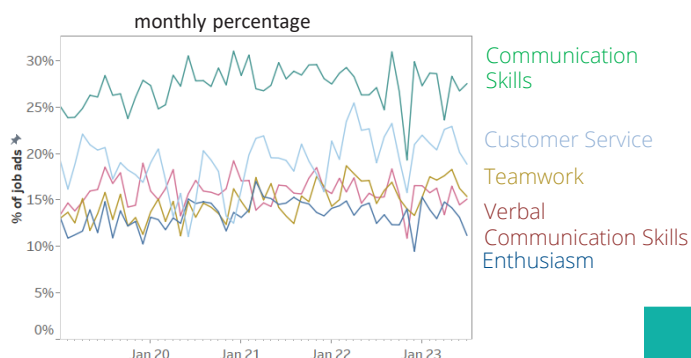

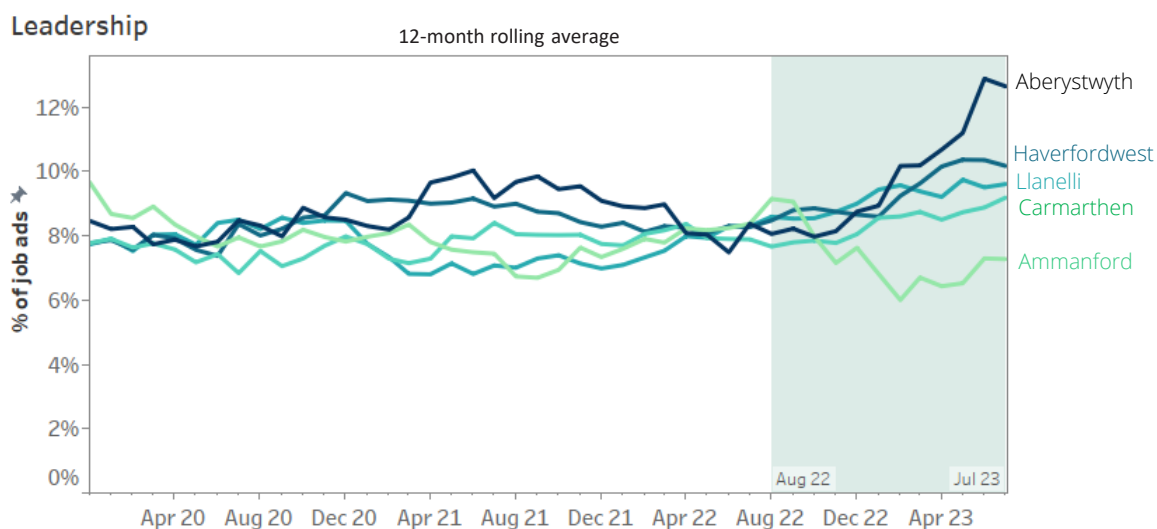

Looking at Leadership, the top trending skill for Mid Wales, it is currently especially popular in Aberystwyth relative to other major settlements in the region.



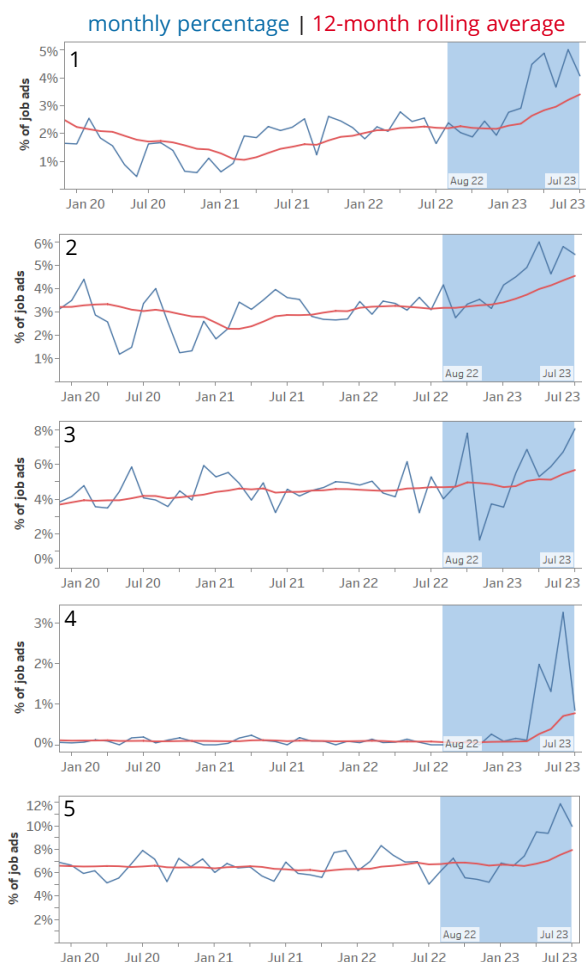

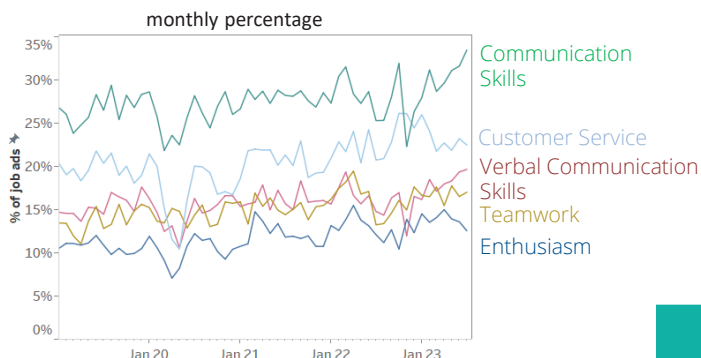

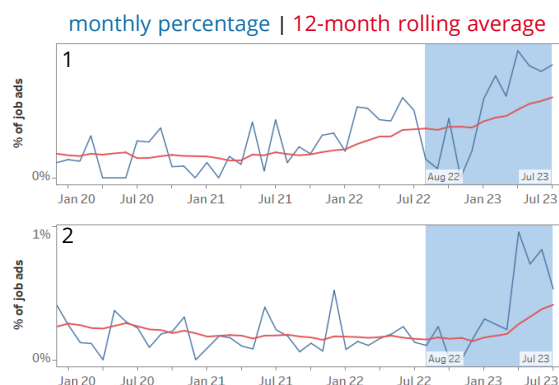

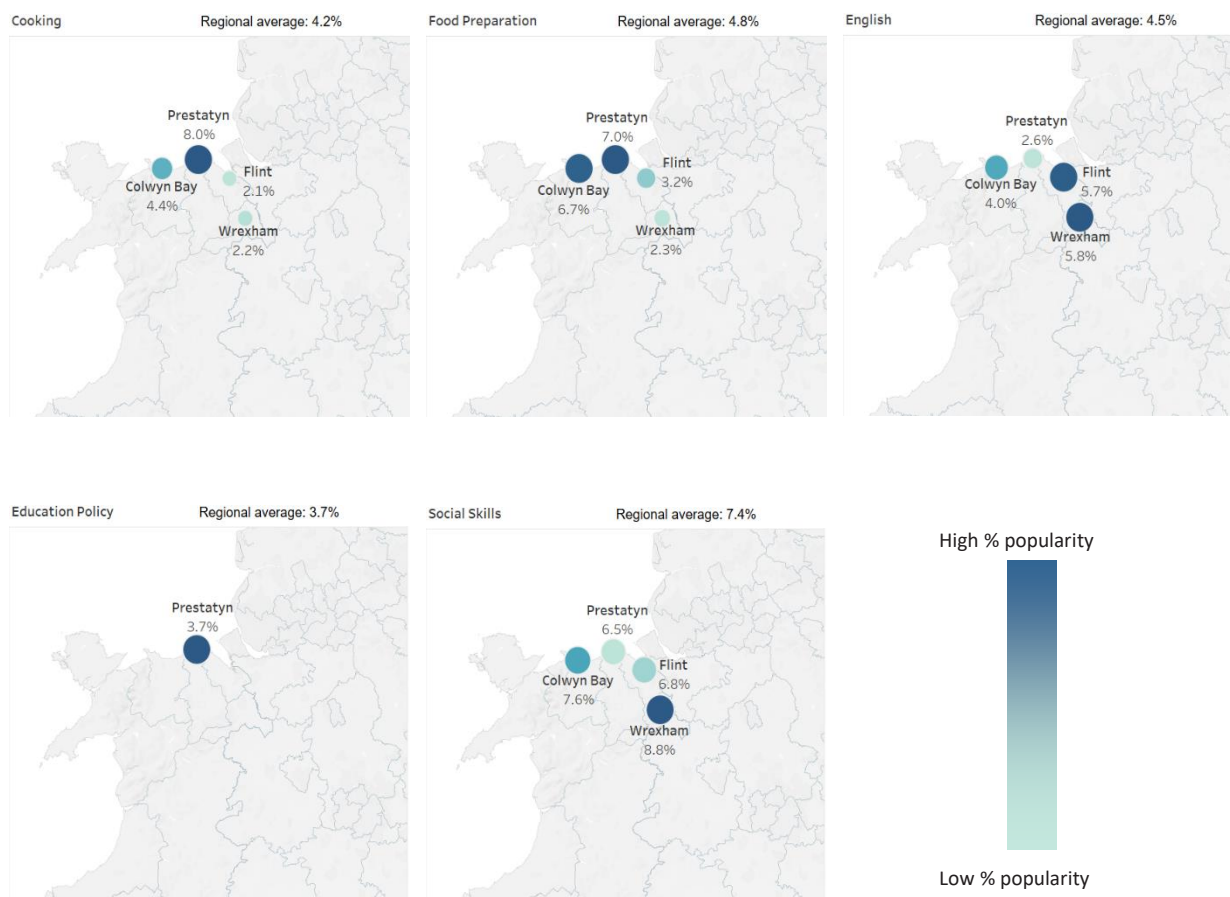
