Importing a Pearson Testbank to Canvas Instructions

To import a Pearson Testbank in an existing Canvas course, download the *Instructor Testbank (Canvas)* from the 'Downloads' tab on the relevant product page at www.pearson.com.au.

NB: you will need to sign-in with your verified pearson.com.au Instructor account to access these materials.


Ensure you are logged in Canvas with editing rights, as an instructor for example, and click the *Modules* link in course menu. Click *Add existing content*.

- Click *Choose file* button and browse for the downloaded Testbank on your computer
- Select a preferred question bank (if you do not have an existing question bank, you can create a new one within the dropdown)
- Choose *All content*
- Click *Import*
