


## Importing a Pearson Testbank to Canvas Instructions

To import a Pearson Testbank in an existing Canvas course, download the *Instructor Testbank (Canvas)* from the 'Downloads' tab on the relevant product page at [www.pearson.com.au](http://www.pearson.com.au).

*NB: you will need to sign-in with your verified pearson.com.au Instructor account to access these materials.*

- Choose *All content*
- Click *Import*
