New South Wales	Currently reviewing NSW syllabuses to incorporate Version 9.0. New syllabus for mathematics Years 7 to 10 from Term 1, 2024. See <u>further information of NSW response</u> .
Northern Territory	All schools required to implement Version 9.0 but a date has yet to be advised. See <u>further information of NT response</u> .
Queensland	All schools required to implement the Australian Curriculum Version 9.0. Schools may implement it any time between Term 1, 2023 and Term 1, 2026. See <u>further information of QLD response</u> .
South Australia	All schools required to implement Version 9.0 but a date has yet to be advised. See <u>further information of SA response</u> .
Tasmania	All schools required to implement Version 9.0 but a date has yet to be advised. See <u>further information of TAS response</u> .
Victoria	Currently reviewing Version 9.0 with the aim of incorporating it into the Victorian Curriculum. All schools will continue to teach the current Victorian curriculum F-10 until advised to change. See <u>further information of VIC response</u> .
Western Australia	Currently reviewing Version 9.0 with the aim of adapting it to the Western Australian Curriculum. All schools will continue with the current WA Curriculum until advised to change. See further information of WA response.
